RECENT ACCOMPLISHMENTS, June 2009

First, Jonathan successfully represented Mississippi gaming legend Rick Schilling, who built the first casino in Tunica, *Splash*. Rick sold his 25% interest in *Harlow's Casino* in Greenville, MS. *Harlow's* revenues increased in 2008 and again in 2009 -- unlike most casino properties -- but the struggle for control with private equity players had become contentious.

Second, Jonathan is pleased to represent GameTech in Reno, NV, as both attorney and lobbyist in the California electronic bingo market. A brand-new regulatory structure is being fleshed out in public hearings as well as the courts.

Third, Jonathan co-authored a recent article in *Global Gaming Business*, "*Swapping Out Debt: Solving The Riddle Of Debt-Asset Swaps And Triangular Deal Structures*", with Steve Gallaway, a very bright guy at Gaming Market Advisors.

Fourth, Jonathan is now Chair of the Litigation Section of 4,000-lawyer Beverly Hills Bar Association. There are over 800 civil litigators in the Section. Jonathan is in his second terms on the BHBA Board of Governors.
