Jonathan Stein is pleased to announce that Jonathan and his co-counsel have reached a 7-figure settlement in a series of federal lawsuits in the Middle District of Florida, including Canaveral Port Authority v. M/V Surfside Princess, et al., Case No. 6:09-cv-01919-JA-DAB; Orchard Drive, LLC v. M/V SunCruz VI, Case No. 6:10-cv-00246-JA-DAB; Orchard Drive, LLC v. M/V SunCruz VIII, Case No. 6:10-cv-00245-JA-DAB; Shaunna Mann, Rodney Mann, Kelly Coleman, Richard Lanigan, and James Belfi on behalf of a Class Comprised of the Other Similarly Situated Former Employees of Class Defendants, v. Orchard Drive, LLC and Fortress Investment Group LLC, Case No. 6:10-cv-172-J28-DAB, as well as In re Oceans Casinos, In re Ventures South Carolina and In re Vessel Casinos in the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Southern District of Florida, Case Nos. 09-38645-RBR, 09-38652-RBR and 09-38657-RBR.

Jonathan represented 660 gaming and non-gaming personnel in these actions against a special purpose entity of Fortress Investment Group, LLC, a publicly-listed \$10-billion equity fund manager. Fortress was represented by a 6-lawyer team from Greenberg Traurig, PC, the largest firm in Florida. Among the cases settled were three admiralty actions, where Jonathan represented 324 gaming and non-gaming personnel that worked on “cruise to nowhere” vessels, and in which settlements were for 100% of damages claimed. These were Jonathan’s first admiralty cases. #####
