Jonathan Stein is pleased to announce that University of North Carolina Press will publish *Sovereignty Struggles and Native Rights In the United States: State and Federal Recognition.*

Jonathan and his co-author Alexa Koenig of University of California Berkeley School of Law (Boalt Hall) contributed the chapter entitled, “*State Recognition Of American Indian Tribes: The Federalist Process.*” The college textbook is expected to be used in college, graduate and post-graduate course work, as well as by the interested community of Native American leaders, state and federal officials, lawyers and anthropologists.

Jonathan’s chapter surveys the 73 American Indian tribes recognized by 21 different states, and compares and categorizes the various state recognition processes. It updates a previous law review article and comprises the first academically rigorous survey of state-recognized Indian tribes conducted. Jonathan has worked for 10 years with the state-recognized Gabrielino-Tongva Tribe, which holds a final judgment declaring its Indian title to Los Angeles County. Jonathan has helped the Tribe pursue its inchoate rights to conduct gaming, among other things. #####
